Flag Removal Day - 2018

Saturday, June 2nd - 9:00 am - Rain or Shine!

- **Meet in the center, hemi-cycle** of the cemetery - for assignments
- **Everyone is welcome** – bring all of your friends (yes, all of them :)
 - Kids can help, too!
- **Please bring shop rags**, old towels, cut up t-shirts, etc.
 - To wipe the mud off the staffs, as flags are pulled up
- **Bring a lawn chair** or camp chair, if you'd like - entirely optional

** It may be wet and muddy in the cemetery – bring a rain poncho & boots*

Here is what we will do: *(*This is subject to change, depending on weather)*

- **9:00 am - Meet in the center Hemi-cycle for team assignments:**
- **Next – in your cemetery sections:**
 - **Pull up the flags / Wipe off staffs**
 - **Bundle flags in groups of 20 – and rubber band tightly**
 - 1 rubber band at the top – wrapped twice around
 - 1 rubber band at the bottom – wrapped 3 times around
 - **Put Flag Bundles in the Totes**
 - **PLEASE do not move totes** up onto the lawn – per the cemetery
 - **Trucks will pick up totes & bring to the center**
- **When your section is finished - Please help** in other areas
 - **We will have various work stations in the center area**
 - Please let the leaders direct you where you are needed
 - We'll show you what to do – it's easy
- **This year the flags will be stored in Cleburne, TX**
 - **We are looking for new storage space in Houston**
